(sleeps more and plays less)



(matted and scruffy coat)



(has a hard time climbing stairs)

Have you noticed that your cat has a hard time jumping or climbing, moves slower, sleeps more or interacts with you less?

Your cat could be telling you it has osteoarthritis.

Osteoarthritis is a degenerative joint disease which is primarily caused by general wear and tear of cartilage within joints leading to inflammation and pain. While there is no cure for joint disease, treatment options are available to manage pain and help get your cat back to their normal self.
